BACKGROUND

- The Internal Spending Rules of the Senate of College Councils are the document governing and regulating all organizational spending
- It is important to review and amend this document, where appropriate, to reflect current practices

PURPOSE

- This bill seeks to amend the Internal Spending Rules to match current and most efficient practices

SUMMARY

- The proposed updates give College Councils more time to submit Summer Budgets
- These updates also institutionalize the practice of external Senate budgets as separate from New Programs and Fundraising

ENACTED SUMMARY

Lines 15-20 Change the name of Section 3

Lines 22-29 Separates council support from New Programs and Fundraising

Lines 31-37 Updates subsection numbering

Lines 39-52 Change the practice of March 'Letter of Intent' to May Summer Budgets allowing councils to use funds in the summer
