BACKGROUND	➤ S.B. 1002 was passed in Fall 2010 adding in specific language about the timing of the question/answer period after the introduction of legislation.

PURPOSE	➤ This legislation is trying to extend that question/answer period to ten minutes.

SUMMARY	➤ This legislation changes the language in Bylaw II of the Senate of College Councils to extend question/answer to ten minutes.
