4 **Title: In Support of Displaying Waitlist and Enrollment Details in the Course**
5 **Schedule**

7 **WHEREAS,** Currently, students are not able to see the enrollment figures for courses that they
8 would like to register for, and if there is a waitlist, what the figures for that
9 waitlist are; and,

11 **WHEREAS,** The ability for students to be able to register for courses efficiently is key to
12 maintaining efficiency in the registration process and advising process; and,

13
14 **WHEREAS,** Allowing students to see enrollment figures reduces the communication burden
15 between students and advisors required for students as they attempt to enroll in
16 required courses; and,

17
18 **WHEREAS,** The inability for students to see these figures causes students to take unnecessary
19 steps as they plan out different scenarios to ensure that their schedules allow them
20 to register for required courses; and,

22 **WHEREAS,** The simple way to mitigate this is to provide a waitlist viewing feature on the
23 Course Schedule so that students may see more clearly what their chances are for
24 being enrolled into a class and can plan accordingly; therefore, be it,

26 **RESOLVED,** That the Registrar's Office shall improve the Course Schedule to display the
27 enrollment cap along with the current enrollment figures for all courses, which
28 shall be continually updated; and, be it further

29
30 **RESOLVED,** That students shall additionally be able to see how many students are on the
31 current waitlist, if there is one, for a given course; and, be it further,

33 **RESOLVED,** That students shall be able to view these numbers before registering for the class;
34 and be it further,

36 **RESOLVED,** That this resolution be sent to Shelby Stanfield, Registrar, Provost Steven Leslie,
